A message from Pastor Scott on ELCA Disaster

Response: You don't have to be a part of OSLC long before you are made aware of the ELCA's work to address disasters through Lutheran Disaster Response. It's an awesome group where 100% of donations go to the intended purpose since administrative costs are addressed in the mission support which congregations like ours pass on to the synods and churchwide expression of the ELCA from our budgets.

So now we're on the other side of this from usual. We're the ones in need. LDR especially shines in the long term concerns of rebuilding that can take years, a time when most everyone else has left - including the television cameras. But they wanted to do something for us in the early stages post-tornado. So I met with a representative today from St. Louis. He brought with him 100 \$100 gift cards (that's \$10,000!) for us to distribute to those impacted by the tornado or flooding.

We will be developing a plan for how best to administer these funds over the next nine months. There are, of course, procedures to follow and paper-work for good order. If you have a suggestion for needs, please contact Pastor Scott.
