We do so because the summer often has lower offerings alongside the fact that each year usually has some unforeseen need arise. We are currently paying our bills with no problem, but there are some items to address. This has been quite the year with much unforeseen. Offerings have been great until last month when they dipped. At the same time, we budget \$5000 a year for outreach fundraisers which isn't going to happen in 2020. Beyond that, we've had some unusual expenses in this unusual year. As you may know, the AV team has been working hard to enhance our online efforts. Even some of our most traditional onsite-oriented folks have been calling attention to some other churches that might be doing "better" with online worship presentation. A big part of the struggle for us is that we are working with mostly ten-year-old equipment. That creates havoc with the new software required to do streaming. The bottom line is that it's time for this year's special appeal. As is usual, there will be a matching gift up to \$3500. So, we're praying for a total by September 27th of at least \$7000. Thank you for your amazing generosity in general. Thank you in addition if you feel called to make a contribution for this particular effort.
