There will be materials sent out via email to facilitate these worships which have been developed by the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America's World Hunger division. Maundy Thursday (April 1) and Good Friday (April 2) worships will also be at 7 pm via Zoom.

Preparing for Ash Wednesday - Ash Wednesday historically has the imposition of ashes upon one's forehead during worship. And you can still do that if you desire at home. But this year we're going to include another aspect of ashes. From now until February 17th, you are encouraged to write down on paper each time you feel there's a distraction from the joy God hopes for you. Then on Ash Wednesday, burn that piece of paper, turning all that would threaten your God-intended joy to ashes.

<u>Next Steps in Reaching Out -</u> Online worship is great for connecting to new people. But it's not enough. How do we build faith community? How do we come alongside people in their many and diverse needs?
