A thought on God’s calling from the Theology of Work Project:

It is important to start our exploration of calling with the call to follow Jesus. It is a call to a restored relationship with God and with other people and with the world around us. It encompasses all of a person’s being and doing. It reminds us that the call to a *particular* kind of work is secondary to the call to belong to Christ and to participate in his redemption of the world.

A thought from Pastor Scott:

There are six people in the Bible who respond “Here I am” when they sense God calling them to some Godly desire. They are Abraham (a call to leave his homeland and father God’s people), Jacob (a call to be the namesake “Israel” for the nation of God’s people), Moses (a call to bring God’s people out of slavery), Samuel (a call to anoint people for leadership), Isaiah (a call to speak God’s promise of the Messiah), and Ananias (a call to anoint Paul as the first one to take Jesus to the nations). How do you hear God’s call for your life? How do you respond?
