THE 2026 KINDNESS PROJECT As a reminder, 2025 was the first year that money was set aside in our church Outreach budget to implement a community kindness project. The OSLC Project Kindness Committee was responsible for reaching out into the community to become familiar with not-for-profit, charitable and humanitarian organizations that we could partner with to make a positive impact in the lives of people who are in need of not only our financial support but also our love and kindness. Representatives from various organizations were invited to come to Our Savior's to make presentations to our congregations (both the early and second services) to share with us their organization's purpose and mission. Making sure that our congregation was kept informed and involved in this campaign was one of the most important components of the Kindness Project Committee as they responsibly determined how the \$12,000 would be spent. We all learned a great deal about the various needs in Jefferson City. Our congregation was able to knowingly help our committee make decisions. Recipients of our grants were: Common Ground, Independent Living Organizations, Ramsey Garden, Healing House, Missouri Cares Soup Kitchen. And, as a result of the various presentations, individuals from our congregations requested Thrivent grants that were used to help support the following organizations: Room at the Inn, Halo, and Red Slipper Warriors; and a food and clothing drive plus a cash donation was provided to Calvin's Closet. **We are beginning to make plans for our 2026 Kindness Campaign. Different organizations will be invited to come to our services again this year to make presentations about their organization's purpose and mission. IMPORTANT: If anyone has any ideas or suggestions about different groups or existing programs that you would like us to consider as beneficiaries this year, please let Pastor Joel know. Thanks to everyone in our congregation for your outpouring of generosity. Our Savior's accomplishes multiple acts of kindness every single day without even trying. A smile, a handshake, a simple question as "HOW CAN I HELP?" is an everyday occurrence that we are all used to here at Our Savior's. What a blessing we have ifrom Jesus and one another!**
